

JAE INTRO ICU AT IFCA (MODALITY B)

- **Deadline for submitting proposals:** From June 1st to June 15th 2020.
- **Number of scholarships:** 2 scholarships
- **Period and duration of each scholarship:** the duration will be 10 consecutive months, to be carried out in the 2020-2021 academic year, from 1st October 2020 to 31st July 2021.
- **Amount of each scholarship:** 9250 euros, at 925 euros per month
- **Maximum weekly dedication time of the beneficiaries of the scholarship:** between 20 and 25 hours a week.
- **Specific requirements of the applicants:**
 - *Branch Degree:* To be or to have finished the studies of Licentiate or Degree in Areas/Specialties of formation in Physics, and not to be in possession or legal disposition to obtain a Doctor's degree. Those Physics students that have completed a degree of at least 180 ECTS are also allowed to apply. Similarly, those students with degrees with at least 240 ECTS from related topics (for instance Maths, Chemical Engineering, Computing Engineering or Telecommunications Engineering) will also be allowed to apply, provided the commission considers that their formation in Maths, Physics and Computing is sufficient and can be complemented, if required, with additional formative courses.
 - *Average grade of the student record:* Accredited an average grade of 7.50 or higher on a scale of 0-10 with 2 decimals.
 - *Official University Master's Degree:* the applicant will study the University Master in Particle and Cosmos Physics during the 2020-2021 academic year.
 - Other merits that will be considered by the Selection Committee:
 - a) To have completed the required studies of Degree or Bachelor in the academic year 2017-2018 or later
 - b) Students must prove that they have a command of English above a level equivalent to B2.

- **Work topics offered and responsible researchers**

The granted will be assigned to the supervision of a researcher of the IFCA staff, according to his/her profile and preferences shown in the application, and in case this one is not available, another one will be assigned according to his/her interests and with the approval of the Academic Commission of the Master in Particle and Cosmos Physics. In justified cases, there

may be co-supervisions with other researchers from the IFCA or other national or foreign research centres.
